

Gardens and Grandeur

A Day Visit to Sumner County, TN



Begin the day with a tour of **Cragfont**, built by General James Winchester who was a founder of Memphis. Referred to as “The Grandeur of the Frontier,” it was the first home with a ballroom in Tennessee, and had parties with guests including Andrew Jackson and Sam Houston. (1 hr, \$4.00 pp)

Admire the roses at **Rose Mont**, once a 500 acres thoroughbred horse breeding plantation. Its unique design makes it one of the best examples of Greek revival architecture in the state. With ties to both the Civil War and World War II, hear how the former mistress of the house stood up to one of the nation’s top leaders. (1 hr, \$4.00 pp)

The serenity of **Spring Haven Mansion** makes the perfect setting for a relaxing lunch on the veranda. This elegant 1825 privately owned home has ties to Adelia Acklen, who is said to have been the inspiration for the character Scarlett O’Hara. (1 ½ hr, \$18.50 pp)



Stroll through the beautiful gardens at the **Thomas Austin House**, a privately owned home that was featured in *Early American Life Magazine*. Hear tales of the restoration process from the charming owners as they guide you through the lovely home filled with period antiques and décor. (1 hr, \$4.00 pp)

End the afternoon with a visit to **Sumner Crest Winery**. Taste the wines made on the premise by grapes grown from Sumner County vineyards. Also, enjoy some time shopping among the many exquisite antiques and gift items found in the gift shop. (1 hr., Free)
